Notation: Signed and dated lower left: R. Jahns 24. Once more signed, dated and inscribed on the frame rear panel: Rudolf Jahns 1924, Komposition (R5).

Frame/Pedestal: Box frame.

On the frame rear panel is the dedication: Meiner Tochter Barbara Roselieb, Detmold, zur Sammlung übereignet, Holzm. 16/9. 61, RJahns. Here additionally inscribed: TA 5.
