Description: Each showing a man lying on his back resp. on his front, skinned and with larger muscles removed

Mark: On a bronze plate: Jules Talrich. Modeleur d'anatomic Faculté le Medecine Paris. Boulevard St. Germaine, 97.

Condition B/C. Base plate broken, partly restored and repainted.

Talrich was a well-known French anatomist, sculptor and keroplast. He became famous through a series of four life-size plaster casts, which were shown at the 1867 World Exhibition in Paris. The present pair shows two of these models in a smaller version.
