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### IMPORTANT SNAKE-BANGLE.

Origin: Presumably France.

Date: Mid 19th century.

Material: 750/- white gold, tested.

Description: Very beautiful example of the, in the mid 19th century popular, snake bangle. In Romanticism, snake bracelets and bangles were a very popular piece of jewellery, often several were worn on one arm.

The example here excels through an artfully intertwined body as well as finely chased hinges and underside. The eyes adorned with rubies, the snake extends its tongue to take in the weather. The enamel is in exquisite condition. Verso dated to 1847.
