Technique: Softwood with pigments.

Description: Two doors, inside drawer. On the two upper door panels Mary and Joseph on the search for shelter and a representation of the flight to Egypt resp. Below large, airily painted bouquets of flowers. On the wreath indistinctly referred to, below "Joseph Clo" and motto: "He who loves God right has the most beautiful art, Anno 1774".
