other. Eyes worked à jour and underlaid with slightly opaque plastic to allow the light of

the interior lighting to shine through.

Measurement: Height 82cm.

Mark: On the backside inscribed 'Förster Deposé 216', minted. On the upper side of the top book inscribed 'Doblinger

903' in black. Electrified.
