On the vases in round cartouches on each side a different representation, which is mirrored on the other vase. Three gentlemen are shown in a garden landscape around a rock table beneath large pines. Around the medallions a frame with flowers, the sides of the vase with connected swastika and red peonies. Measurement: H. 38.5cm, w. 27cm, th. 7.5cm. Condition B/C. One with a large crack at the opeing. Restored at the handles.
