The artwork is a drapo Vodou or Vodou flag. Such flags were originally created for voodoo temples and showed voodoo scenes and deities. This type of richly beaded flag was designed in the 1990s by Myrlande Constant, a former bridal fashion dressmaker, and elevated to an art form in its own right.
