SPLENDID BAROQUE FIR WOOD BED WITH EPISCOPAL COAT OF ARMS.

Date: Dated 1734.

Technique: Carved, partially painted fir wood. Embroideries.

Description: Richly decorated foot and head piece with blossoms, acanthus leaves, volutes and rocailles. In reserves dated 17 AD 34 and Maria Immaculata.
