SCHIESTL, RUDOLF
1878 Würzburg - 1931 Nuremberg

Title: Spalter Land ("Kirchgang").
Study for the painting with the same name from 1920.
Technique: Gouache over charcoal drawing on paper.
Mounting: Mounted on paper. Measurement: 22 x 30cm. Notation: Inscribed vertically bottom left: Bildstudie: Kirchengänger (?).
Frame/Pedestal: Matted, framed behind glass.
Estate stamp of the artist on the drawing and the underlying paper at lower right.

Condition:
Sheet light-stained, minimally stained and wavy. Slight crease at left sheet edge, slightly worn on all sheet edges. Holes from drawing board pins at the four corners.
Frame: Overall in good condition.
Mat: Minimal stains in places.

In the present sheet, which was part of the artist's estate, the bold, splendid colours, which are characteristic for Rudolf Schiestl's paintings, stand out. The present print - a study for the 1920 painting - was probably used to explore the effect of the colours within the extensive Franconian landscape in the Spalter Land.
