Becher: Minimal bumping of the upper right corner. Bremer: Paper minimally wavy due to the creation process. Slight traces of handling at the lower sheet edge. Girke: Sheet edges minimally wavy. Goepfert: Minimal scratches and rubbing in the silver area. Here additionally a small pressure mark due to paper damage verso. Graves: Verso with minimal stains. Krieg: In the print area slightly wavy due to the creation process. Kuwayama: One slight pressure mark in the left, silver-coloured area. Lechner: Minimal bumping of the upper right corner. Le Va: Minimal bumping at the lower edge. Martinez: Bumping along the left sheet edge. Petrick: Slight bumping of the upper right corner. Spadari: Surface with slight rubbing, especially in the black area. Wewerka: Minimal crease in the lower left area. Imprint with notes from the previous owner. Case with slight traces of use.
