LARGE LIDDED SILVER TANKARD WITH SPHERIC FEET AND CREST.

Meister IFS. Moskau.

Date: 1737.

Technique: Partially gilt silver with gilt interior.

Description: On three large spheric feet with fruit and acanthus décor, cylindrical corpus with fruit festoons in relief on ribbons. On the front a large coat of arms relief with pyr under crest. The flat hinged lid on the top with corresponding engraved décor and a central profile portrait of Emperor Charles V in relief. Spherical thumb rest and large C-shaped handle with fruit decoration and shield finial, repeating the coat of arms on the front .
