From 1871, the still young Theodor Hagen was based in Weimar, first as professor of landscape painting at the local art academy, and a few years later as its director. He remained in Weimar until the end of his life and became one of the most important representatives of German Impressionism - an outstanding position that has unfortunately often been forgotten and is only slowly being appreciated anew in the form of exhibitions.

Theodor Hagen probably painted the wide panorama of his home town shown here, with the banks of the Rhine and the characteristic tower of the Lamberti Church, from memory in Weimar.
