After Robert Sterl's death in 1932, his widow Helene sifted through the artistic estate and drew up an inventory listing around 500 works, mostly oil studies and sketches. These were numbered on the reverse and often also provided with a subsequent monogram. In the course of the world economic crisis, Helene Sterl had to sell many works from the estate via the Dresden art trade.
