This etching is the last trial proof before the edition which the printer Pennequin printed for the Atelier Crommelynck. With the note "Bon à Tirer" (good to print), Picasso released it as a template for the edition. The edition of 50 signed and numbered copies was then published in 1965 by the Galerie Louise Leiris in Paris.
