From an unknown edition size. The workshop took place in coopoeration with Thyssen-Bornemisza Art Contemporary as part of the 57th International Art Exhibition of the Biennale in Venice VIVA ARTE VIVA in 2017.

The project originated as response to the current geopolitical situation, in which millions of people become refugees because of war and violence, and it generally refers to the migation issue. Refugees and asylum seekers metaphorically get 'green light' and were invited to patricipate in the project. Apart from building green lamps, language courses, seminars, and film screenings were part of the workshop.
