Description: Small oval tray with curved rim, miniature tazza (mark French Cygne), miniature tankard, two small round boxes possibly for pomanders, a small gilt round box (mark "P (?)C" under crown), a rectangular casket made of delicate wire with pearl, a small glass bottle with 'Nuppen' décor, a small glass bowl with handle, a gilt miniature tureen (mark "P(?)C" under crown), a small pendant in the shape of a vase.
