PENDULE NARCISSE.

Badier. Paris

Date: Early 19th century.

Technique: Gilt bronze.

Description: Rectangular pedestal with panel, decorated with a shallow relief. It shows a fine depiction of Narcissus lying by the spring, falling in love with his reflection. On top of the pedestal the three-dimensional figurine of Narcissus approaching the spring. The clock case in the shape of a stela with reeds and a water surface. Enamel dial with Roman numerals. Round 14-day pendulum movement. Thread suspension and half hour strike on bell.

Measurement: 37x31x13,5cm.

Mark: On dial inscr. "Badier à Paris" (Rue Saint-Germain l'Auxerrois, Horloger en pendules, 1812).
