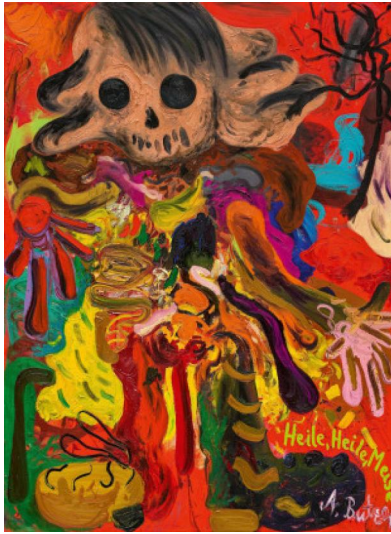

Verso and on the outer edge there are various drawing of hands as well as the inscriptions: Meisenschande, Insel in der Sonne, Flaschesonne!, Meisen, Amseln. Additionally there is an inscription on the stretcher centre: Schandemeisen!.
