Date: 1777-87.

Technique: Silver.

Description: Round base with several recesses and baluster stem with rose vines in relief. Base and baluster stem with roses in relief. The two-flame top with vine frame and leaf nozzles.

Weight: Ca. 780g.

Measurement: Height 31cm, width 33,5cm.

Mark: Both parts with inspection mark Berlin for 1777-87 (Scheffler, Berlin no. 10b), maker's mark Daniel Matignon (1763-91, *ibid.* 182), testing mark, Prussian tax stamp from 1809.

Estimate: 2.800 € - 3.800 €; Hammer: 2.600 €
