Technique: Archival dyes, fabric and metal press studs on two panels of fabric sewn together.

Measurement: 44,5 x 59,5cm.

Frame/Pedestal: Box frame. Not examined out of the frame.

The left half of the diptych is a print after the watercolour "The Family" (2007).

- The work was created in 2008, two years before the artist's death, when she reflected once again on the mother-child relationship at the high age of 97
- In "The Endless Loop", the artist extends the theme to the family and succeeds in depicting with simple means the relationship of a family in all its never-ending interconnectedness
