SILVER MASS CHALICE WITH ACANTHUS AND VINES ORNAMENTATION.

Hartmann, Heinrich Diderich. Osnabrück.

Date: Ca. 1690.

Technique: Silver and gilt silver.

Description: Sixfoiled foot, several times recessed and ending flat at the top. Merging into a sixfoiled shaft with a waisted node. The latter with acanthus vines and attached cherub heads. Cuppa basket pierced to blossoms and vines with a smooth, flared cuppa.

Weight: Ca. 290g.

Measurement: Height 18,5cm.

Mark: Inspection mark Osnabrück (Scheffler Niedersachsen no.1958), maker's mark Heinrich Diderich Hartmann (1680/81-1729, ibid. no.1965).

Monogrammed at the bottom of the foot rim "A.W" resp. "M.F.O".

Estimate: 800 € - 1.000 €; Hammer: 1.100 €
