Lettré, Emil. Berlin.

Date: Ca. 1930.

Technique: Silver. The handles covered with leather.

Description: Consisting of a large tray, coffee pot, tea pot and milk jug. Slender vessel shapes with four austere acanthus leaves running over the entire height. The large round tray also with stylised acanthus leaves between straight bars on the flat flared rim.

Weight: Ca. in total 3093g.

Measurement: Tray ø 46cm, pots 24,5/ 15/ 10cm.

Mark: Each with maker's mark Emil Lettré (1928 - 1952).
