PORCELAIN FIGURINE OF COURT JESTER JOSEPH FRÖHLICH WITH HAT.

Meissen.

Date: 1924-1934.

Maker/Designer: Model J. J. Kaendler.

Technique: Porcelain, painted in colours and sparingly golden.

Description: Self-confident, with his hands in his braces, Augustus the Strong's 'merrymaker', the court jester Joseph Fröhlich, with pointed hat in wide trousers and boots, stands broad-legged on a base. The figure was varied several times by Kaendler and in this model type was given a hat ornament of flowers and a gold decoration on the braces with the initials 'J. F.' and the year '1739'.

Measurement: Height 24,5cm.

Mark: Swords mark with dot, painted blue under glaze. Porcelain former's number 50, model number 134.
