Minimally wavy due to the manufacturing process. Remains of an old mounting in the upper right corner of the sheet. Minimal staining to the upper left corner of the sheet and the lower right corner. Mounted in the mat window in two places verso and remains of an old mounting. Otherwise in very good condition.
