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### BRONZE PENDULUM WITH BACCHANTE.

France.

Date: 1st half 19th c.

Maker/Designer: Presumably after a model by André-Antoine Raviro.

Technique: Bronze, fire-gilded.

Description: On an oval base young bacchante with moving antique garment in a dancer-like movement.

Balancing a rod on her right shoulder and attached to this the drum-formed clock case with bells and cymbals. Enamel dial with Roman numerals. 14-day-pendulum movement with thread suspension, half-hour chime on bell.

Measurement: 39x23x11cm.

Enamelled dial chipped at the winding holes.

Enclosed: P/S.
