Technique: Silver.

Description: On three bun feet with bird claws the cylindrical body with five integrated coins. An additional one in the centre of the flatly domed hinged lid. On the body and the lid Régence decor, the large push piece in the form of a lion. On the interior five-part scale for determining the filling quantity. At the top owner's monogram and year engraved "MKS + AMD + 1721".

Weight: Ca. 810g.

Measurement: Height 19,5cm.

Mark: Without inspection mark, maker's mark Peter Norman (1719-1761, Boje p.246).

On the bottom engraved weight indication.

Estimate: 2.000 € - 2.500 €; Hammer: 2.600 €
