### SILVER TRAVELING SHRINE, SO-CALLED GA'U.

Technique: Silver, repoussé, fabric among other.

Description: Two-part, rectangular amulet container. The glazed, leaf-shaped altar window on the front is flanked by two opposing dragons in a drift, with a Mahakala head and an emblem of Lakshmi between them. Inside, a relief of the Buddha Akshobhya. In a coloured fabric bag with carrying strap.
