The former blue colour areas have faded.

The work is registered at the Fondation Le Corbusier, Paris, under the number 396.

This work is a typical depiction from a series of drawings by Le Corbusier showing women at work (or resting) in a holiday home in Le Piquey in the Bay of Arcachon.
