SNAKE-OPAL-NECKLACE.

Origin: England.

Date: Third quarter of the 19th century.

Material: 750/- and 585/- yellow gold, tested.

Total Weight: ca. 20,5 g.

Measurement: Length ca. 38,0 cm, pendant ca. 4,5 x 2,3 cm.

Gemstones: 3 opal-cabochons ca. 5,3 - 6,3 mm x 3,3 - 3,8 mm, 8 light pink gemstones presumably garnet ca. 3,0 - 3,3 mm x 2,7 - 3,1 mm.

Description: Clasp with snake head motif, holds a heart medallion in its mouth with rock crystal cover on the back. Enclosed copy of an invoice.

Condition: in good condition for its age, traces of wear in the form of minor to more severe scratches. Gold slightly oxidised.
