COIN-PEARL-DIAMOND-PENDANT NECKLACE.

Material: Platinum and 750/- yellow gold, tested, coin, was not tested.

Total Weight: ca. 10,0 g.

Measurement: Length ca. 47,0 cm, Pendant ca. 5,0 x 3,7 cm.

Diamonds: 22 diamonds in old-, and rose-cut in total ca. 0,25 ct.

Gemstones: 12 gemstone-carré, presumably ruby in total ca. 0,24 ct.

Organic Matter: 2 seedpearls Ø ca. 3,7 - 4,0 mm, cream-coloured.

Description: Coin presumably made by the Italian sculptor Antonino Gagini in the 16th century. Jesus is depicted on the front, labelled 'Gloria in excelsis deus'. The rear depicts a cross with the Lord's Prayer in Latin, labelled all around 'In hoc signo vinces' and the signature 'ANTONINO'.

Condition: good condition, traces of wear in form of minor to more severe scratches. One pearl is glued on. Coin soldered several times into the setting.

Estimate: 500 € - 600 €; Hammer: 550 €
