A large cartouche with purple lustres and feather decoration on the wall of each jug, each containing garden scenes with two Chinese at tea ceremonies. The spaces between the cartouches are decorated with insects. A golden ornamental band around the rim of the pot and 'Indian' flowers again on the lid of the pot. Measurement: Height 10cm. Mark: Swords mark and "K.P.M.", painted blue under glaze. Gold painter's number 9. Cameo mark of two dots.
