EARLY HORIZONTAL MIXED MEDIA TABLE CLOCK IN ORIGINAL CASE.

Zoll, Benjamin. Danzig

Date: Ca. 1740.

Technique: Case with leather on a wooden core. Clock fire-gilded brass, silver and silver-plated blued steel, glass, etc.  
Description: The case with decorative nails along the upper edge and engraved hinge and lock fittings. Hexagonal case on three feet in the shape of silver-plated lions, with pegs hanging down between them. The sides each with glazed, medallion-shaped windows. Female busts on acanthus consoles on the corners. Silver-plated, broad ring dial with Roman hours and Arabic minutes on a finely engraved background. The blued steel hands finely pierced and engraved. Hour striking mechanism on a bell at the bottom, going train with verge escapement, fusee and chain. Rich movement decoration with engraved tendrils. The verge escapement with Prussian eagle and the base plate are richly engraved.
