Description: High rectangular body with a cracked pediment and a wide drawer in the base. Pediment and

drawer with female nudes and inlaid foliate scrolls. Pilasters in the centre of the

two-door front and on the chamfered corners. Their gilded capitals with mascarons of a hunter, the hunting goddess Diana and a wild boar. The curved panels at the top are finished with gold-plated ornaments. Below, hunting scenes with stag and wild boar hunting

between inlaid trees and framed by fruit festoons and leaf tendrils respectively.
