Description: This mixed lot consists of 3 mourning rings and a buckle ring. Hallmark "In Memory of"; "Oct. 1838 at

77"; "Geo 'Sitster Org?' of? 22" and "Susan Walton died May 25th 1835 Aged 37 Years".

Condition: according to its age in very good condition, traces of wear in the form of minor to more severe scratches. Enamel occasionally with abrasions. One ring wwith minimal traces of restauration and ring rail has been altered in size. Gold oxidised.
