Minimally discoloured. Minimally wavy due to the manufacturing process. Verso minimally discoloured as well as remains of an old mounting. Otherwise in good condition.

Outside of the edition of 370 copies. Originally one of 6 etchings accompanying the book 'Die Fürstin' ('The Princess') by Kasimir Edschmid. The copies were numbered in the colophon of the books.
